

Chlorine



Discovered by Carl Wilhelm Scheele 17



Due to its toxicity, chlorine was used as a chemical weapon during World War I

The name is derived from the Greek word 'chloros', denoting the color of the element i.e. greenish

yellow.

Chlorine contributes to the process of ozone depletion. In fact, one chlorine atom can destroy as many as 100,000 ozone molecules before it is removed from the stratosphere,
